Southern California Edison Encourages Public Participation in Review of Nuclear Plant Regulatory Issues

ROSEMEAD, Calif., Nov. 2, 2009 – San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station management personnel will meet publicly with staff members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff on Nov. 5 to discuss various aspects of plant performance the commission oversees. Residents of neighboring communities are invited to attend.

The meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Trestles Room of the Doubletree Guest Suites at 34402 Pacific Coast Highway, Dana Point, Calif. The public will have an opportunity to ask questions of the NRC staff and plant managers.

“We encourage participation in this public discussion of steps we take to ensure the safe, reliable operation of our San Onofre facility,” said Southern California Edison’s Chief Nuclear Officer Ross Ridenoure.

The San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station is jointly owned by Southern California Edison (78.21%), San Diego Gas & Electric (20%), and the city of Riverside (1.79%).
